

Kihei Canoe Club - 2017 Student Scholarship Announcement, Guidelines, and Application

Overview:

Kihei Canoe Club is offering scholarships to support KCC paddlers' post-high school education. A total of up to five, \$1,000 awards will be distributed among chosen applicants.

Eligibility:

Kihei Canoe Club paddlers are eligible for this award to help fund post-high school education. Those who have participated in Na Opi'o are particularly encouraged to apply. Before receiving an award, applicants must provide documentation of acceptance to an institution of higher learning (community college, four-year college, university, or trade school) or continuing progress in a higher education program. KCC paddlers may win a KCC Scholarship award for up to four years.

Application:

To be considered for funding for the 2017-2018 school year, interested students should complete the attached application, which must be postmarked by June 1, 2017. Late applications will not be accepted.

Each scorer on the Scholarship Committee will rate the applicant on a scale of 0 - 2 for each item.

0 = No evidence presented 1 = Adequate evidence 2= Excellent evidence
